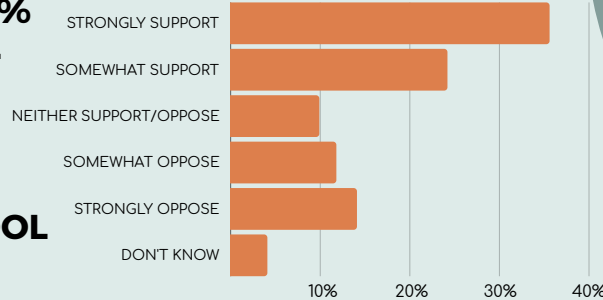


POLLING *voter* M CHARTERS

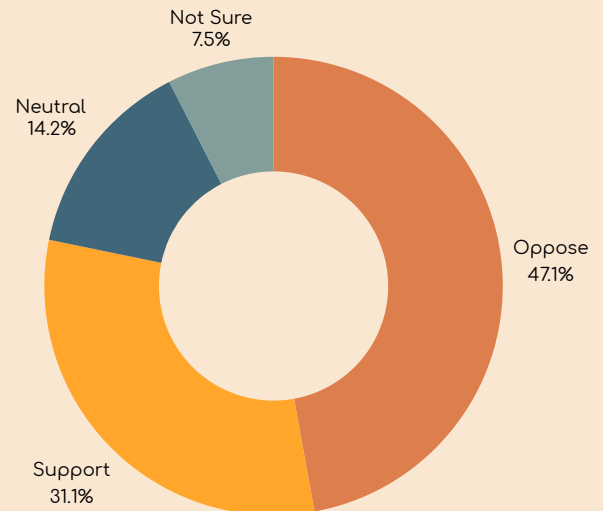
70%
A MAJORITY OF VOTERS (70% TO 12%) BELIEVE THAT CHARTER SCHOOLS SHOULD BE AN OPTION FOR MORE STUDENTS.

VOTERS SUPPORT (60% TO 26%) FUNDING ALL STUDENTS WITH AN EQUITABLE PER-STUDENT FUNDING REGARDLESS OF THE KIND OF PUBLIC SCHOOL THEY ATTEND.

OF VOTERS (85% TO 8%) SUPPORT GIVING MICHIGAN PARENT OPTIONS WHEN CHOOSING A PUBLIC SCHOOL FOR THEIR CHILDREN.

VOTERS DO NOT SUPPORT THE GOVERNOR'S BUDGET PROPOSAL TO CUT 20% FROM THE CYBER CHARTER SCHOOL FUNDING.
